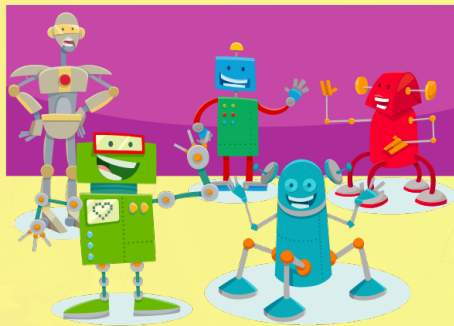

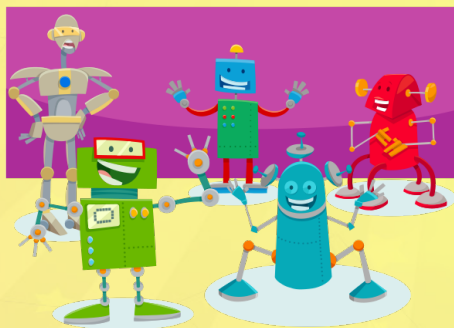

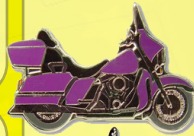


QUEEN ELIZABETH II APPEARS ON MORE CURRENCY than

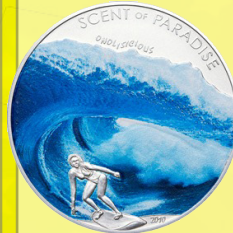

REAL. AMAZING. COINS.

WHILE COINS IN THE USA are usually flat, round and silver (or copper-colored), coins in other parts of the world can be in the shape of almost anything! Here's some of the coolest-looking currency ever!



SOMALIA MOTORCYCLE COINS. Coin collectors in Somalia (a country in East Africa) were revved up about these motorcycle-shaped coins when they were released in 2007. They had a face value of \$1.00, but are collector's items today and sell for about \$10 each.



PALAU SURFER COINS. Not only does this Republic of Palau (Micronesia) coin look really cool, it actually has a tropical smell! The \$5.00 coin was released in 2010 and was created with special scent technology to smell like coconut.



COOK ISLANDS EASTER ISLAND COINS. The Cook Islands (near New Zealand) issued a \$10 coin depicting the famous statues of Easter Island, and they have a VERY unique feature. One of the gold-plated statues can stand upright! We've all heard of pop-up books, but pop-up coins? Now that's crazy cool!
